DfE's recent report- Impact of AI on Jobs



The DfE's Unit for Future Skills has published an initial report exploring the possible impact of AI on jobs in the UK. The report suggests that the greatest impacts could be in roles requiring higher level qualifications, and in professions such as finance and insurance. These roles are weighted towards London and the Southeast of England, which are therefore likely to be hardest hit [Impact of AI on Jobs in the UK](#)

Oxford Applicant Advice for New Testing Service



This update on testing arrangements for 2024 entry has advice for applicants, as Cambridge Assessment Admissions Testing (CAAT) announced its decision to withdraw from delivering its admissions testing services over the next two years. From now, [Tata Consultancy Services \(TCS\)](#) will manage the delivery of Oxford's own tests. Schools and colleges will need to apply for authorisation to become Oxford/TCS test centres (even if already CAAT centres) before being able to register applicants for Oxford's tests.
